

COMMUNICATION

The Security Secretariat through the Honduran National Police and within the framework of the National Emergency System (SINAGER), in relation to new measures for the WHOLE NATIONAL TERRITORY, communicates:

1. It is declared as of today at 6:00 PM ABSOLUTE CURFEW THROUGH ALL NATIONAL TERRITORY within the framework of the NATIONAL SANITARY EMERGENCY AND RED ALERT FOR CORONAVIRUSES (COVID19).
2. According to PCM 021-2020 executive agreement, this measure will be in force ALL OVER NATIONAL TERRITORY until next Sunday, March 29 at 3:00 in the afternoon, Informing that same day the new decisions to be made to stop the rapid spread of the virus.
3. To supply the population with food, all grocery stores are authorized and markets that open their doors to serve the population in their respective communities.
4. Banasupro's mobile units will circulate through neighborhoods and neighborhoods to serve citizens who require basic products and hand gel.
5. Supermarkets, pharmacies, grocery stores, tortillerías, bakeries and services of express delivery are authorized to deliver products at home, presenting before the police authority their identification card and the delivery order.
6. Agricultural, agro-industrial, agro-exporter and food distributor sector is authorized to continue their work, having to have the safe-conduct corresponding and implement each company biosecurity measures for all its employees as a mandatory requirement to keep its operations open.
7. We inform that the closure of air, sea and land borders is maintained for the movement of people, except freight transport personnel.
8. Foreigners who are in the national territory and want to return to their countries can do it by land or air, with prior authorization of the safe-conduct from SINAGER.
9. The Government of the Republic expresses its ETERNAL thanks to all the personnel Police, Armed Forces, COPECO, Family Guides, medical personnel, nursing, auxiliaries, laboratory workers, freight motorists, government and municipal personnel in cleaning, fumigation, delivery of food, as well as staff who work day and night making masks and biosafety suits.

We are going to get out of this emergency with the unity and solidarity of all the Honduran people.

The Honduran National Police reiterates its commitment and willingness to serve the society, which must collaborate as part of a new culture of coexistence in order to curb the rapid spread of COVID-19.
